- \$1250 in Jan 1960
- Purchased in Chicago
- WWII Surplus
- Last flown in 1944
- Restored by members
- 1500 hrs to restore
- First Flight 9/2/60
- All Metal #465
- 23:1
- Supercub Tow 125 hp
- Stanton tow; \$4

Flew 300 flights in the year 1960

- John Edwards 1960 Chief of Operations; ex marine with 1000 glider flights, also an instructor
- Rusty Bringentoff operated a glider school in Germany before WW II

Interesting Trivia:

May 1961 TG-2 flips over in wind while being towed back to the line major damage, canopy, and tail.

Dec 1962 - club broke; wants to sell the 1-26 but decides to raise membership from 27 to 40. It worked!

May 1963 - Ground dent by Ed Trautwein in TG-2 wing (tow vehicle stopped)

Fees: 1962

Full Share; \$220; with \$165 refund

Dues; \$5.50/month (\$66/yr)

TG-2; \$.04/minute

MSC Tow \$.30/minute (strange!)

Stanton Tow \$3 to 2000'

Sept 1970 Share value=\$320

Oct 1964: K-7 Replaces the TG-2
